



Genesis House Golf Tournament to Raise Money for Family Shelter Expansion

For nearly 30 years, the Genesis House of Olean has provided shelter, hope, and a fresh start to people who are experiencing homelessness or living in an uninhabitable home. The only family shelter in Cattaraugus County, the Genesis House is expanding to accommodate more families, and they're seeking the support of the community through the Genesis House Golf Tournament. Program manager Jim Swatt invites golfers and sponsors to participate in this four-person scramble at Bartlett Country Club on Tuesday, June 7th. With lots of great prizes, delicious meals, and a beautiful course, the tournament promises to be a fun day for a very worthy cause!

According to Swatt, the need for a shelter for women and children became apparent in the 1980s, when the Emergency Aid Coalition was sought for help with the homeless in the Olean community. At that time, the only place offering shelter was the former YMCA, which only housed men. In recognition of this need, a group of local individuals led by Fr. James Snodgrass of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church formed the Homelessness Task Force to create a place for families in need of housing and the resources to move forward with their lives.

In 1993, the house next door to the church was purchased, and an interfaith group comprised of representatives from several congregations initiated the adopt-a-room campaign. This gave businesses and churches the opportunity to sponsor a room to prepare for future guests of the house. In 1994, the house was granted 501-c3 status, and the first family came to stay in the house in January of 1995. The Genesis House was dedicated in February by the following founding congregations: Bethany Lutheran Church, Christ United Methodist Church, First Baptist Church, Franciscan Sisters of Allegany, St. Mary of the Angels Roman Catholic Church, St. Stephen's Episcopal Church and Temple B'Nai Israel. The following congregations have since been added: the Islamic Society of the Southern Tier, Immanuel Lutheran Church, St. John's Lutheran Church, and St. Bonaventure Parish.

In 2009, the Genesis House opened a men's shelter, which can house three men and a manager. In addition to providing safe, temporary housing, the Genesis House provides nutritious meals, essential clothing and personal care items, mentoring and case management, even after guests leave the house. The Genesis House provides referrals for medical assistance and county services and resources, and everyone who completes the program is assisted in obtaining safe, affordable housing and furnishing their new home.

In 2021, 8,580 meals and 2,246 nights of shelter were provided by the Genesis House. On average, 27 families and 20 children are helped by the Genesis House each year. "We have 13 people in the house right now," said Swatt. "We are the only family shelter in the county, and part of our expansion is to open a brand new exclusively family center. Each family will get their own apartment." Currently, families are housed at the women's shelter on Barry Street, but with this expansion, the Barry Street site will become a co-ed shelter with separate rooms for single men and women. The men's shelter will be replaced by a family shelter with two separate apartments to accommodate two families.

Funds raised through the golf tournament will play a vital role in this expansion, said Swatt. "Covid really did affect our fundraising because we had to do things virtually for the past couple of years," he explained. "Even though a virtual event is better than none, it's still not quite the same level of participation, and it's just not as much fun!" The June 7th LET ONE OF OUR FIND THE RIGHT HOME



COURSE SPOTLIGHTS

SPRINGVILLE COUNTRY CLUB

Celebrating 100 years, we look back at the club's rich and unique history

Just 20 miles north of Ellicottville, the Springville Country Club welcomes golfers to its beautiful course on Cascade Road. While the club's location on Cascade may seem like an insignificant detail to some, it is one of the last remnants of what was once the most popular tourist destination in Cattaraugus County: Cascade Park. Around the turn of the 20th century, passengers of the Buffalo, Rochester & Pittsburgh Railway looked forward to this beautiful resort that was once as familiar to tourists as Niagara Falls. Although the BR&P no longer operates as it once did, its impact on Cattaraugus County is still apparent today, a history that has always been honored by Springville Country Club (SCC), which is celebrating its 100th anniversary this year.

Western New York saw a boom in the coal industry throughout the 1850s, and demand continued to rise into the 1870s, when it was determined by business and civic leaders in Buffalo and Rochester that a direct route to Pennsylvania would be the most efficient way to access the region's abundant coal resources. In the 1870s, the railway between Rochester and Pittsburgh was constructed, and at Ashford Junction, between West Valley and Ellicottville, railway construction began north toward Buffalo.

One of the biggest challenges the railroad faced was how to span the Cattaraugus Creek gorge, according to John Nason, chair of the 100 Year Committee and long-time SCC member. The BR&P constructed the original viaduct over Cattaraugus Creek and later moved it to the head of Zoar Valley in 1898. At 185 feet high and 780 feet long, the Cattaraugus Viaduct was an impressive structure, much like the nearby Kinzua Viaduct, though not as large. The creek area's 200-feet high banks, caves, and waterfalls made it the perfect location for picnics and parties during the early 1900s. This beautiful natural setting became one of the most well-known destinations for passengers of the railroad: Cascade Park.

A Springville Journal and Herald article from April 27, 1899 outlined the railroad's plans for their "\$10,000 Pleasure Resort," which started with the seeding and landscaping of farmland that bordered the banks of the Cattaraugus Creek. Eventually, the park included an 80-feet pavilion, smaller pavilions, a kitchen building, a dining room, and a dance hall. Eventually, passenger trains of 10 to 15 coaches departed Buffalo for Cascade Park almost daily during the summer, and the park soon became one of the most popular excursion trips of the BR&P.

The railroad continued to operate Cascade Park until 1921. SCC Golf Professional Dave Thomas said, "By the 20s, travel on the railroad became less popular because people did have cars. The railroad stopped doing the excursions to the park because passenger trips like those became outdated." In 1922, the railroad advertised the 150-acre park for sale for \$10,000.00. Springville native Glenn "Pop" Warner led efforts to buy the land, and approximately 180 Springville-area residents paid \$50 each (equivalent to about \$860 today) for the original share of what became Springville Country Club, said Nason.

"Golf then was different than it is today," Thomas pointed out. "100 years ago, you really had to have money to golf. Purchasing the land was a big investment and the early folks involved gave a lot of money to make the course what it is today." Attorney and college football coaching legend Warner was a regular on the course in the 1920s and would often be seen wandering off with paper and pencil to jot down new plays and formations, said Nason. "He helped lay out the original nine holes of the golf course," Thomas explained. "The original course had sand and oil greens because of the soil make-up in the







Core Performance: Golf is a Game of High Technology Equipment

Golf has become a game of high technology equipment. One often overlooked key piece of equipment is the golfer's body. Is it stable and strong where it needs to be? Is it mobile and flexible where it has to be? A golfer will always perform better and reduce the risk of injury when properly conditioned.

Golf is obviously a game that depends on rotation of the body to deliver power from the ground through the core to the club and finally the ball. Most golfers find it surprising that the lower back, or lumbar spine, is not designed for a lot of rotation. However, you continue to see golf exercises that target flexibility and range of motion in the lower spine. The more effective training strategy is to build stability in the lower spine while working to optimize mobility and power in the hips and upper, or thoracic, spine. One way to both improve performance and reduce the risk of injury is "core" training. The easiest way to think of your core is your body minus your arms and legs. From your hips to your shoulders, that's your core, your power center and your key to performance and longevity.

Core strength for golf can be effectively trained from a standing position with exercises that promote lower back stability with hip and upper back mobility. Suspension training or TRX training is uniquely suited to deliver these qualities. Movements such as the TRX golf rotation exploits reflexive core engagement for lower spine stability allowing proper hip and upper spine movements required for golf. The TRX Balance Lunge and the TRX lunge both integrate single leg balance and stability with core engagement. Plus, core stability training is optimal using the TRX suspension bands. Exercises such as the plank, the pike, hip bridge and side planks are truly at the top of the food chain as highly effective and efficient variations to train core stability and body alignment.

The TRX has become an essential exercise tool for golf performance and injury prevention for coaches, trainers and athletes at all levels. The benefits in flexibility, strength and power are seen almost immediately. Core conditioning is vital for golf, and suspension training is vital for fast and effective core performance.

Inner Peace & Strength: Taking in the Good

Embracing positivity, looking at life with rose colored glasses, living optimistically are all chosen perspectives to allow or take in goodness. For some, allowing goodness to enter into your being comes naturally. For others, it might take some tweaking and adjusting. And for some, there might be a block against taking in the good. Bertrand Russell says, "It is not selfish to take in the good. The good life, as I conceive it, is a happy life. I do not mean that if you are good you will be happy; I mean that if you are happy you will be good. In other words, when our cup runneth over, we're usually more inclined to be giving and helpful to other people." Taking in goodness is a birthright for evervone.

Rick Hanson speaks on the neurobiology of this concept

being primarily the reasons why our brains are wired in somewhat negative ways. He indicates three reasons for this: 1) We do or don't treat ourselves well. 2) Things happen to us. 3) Our brain has what is called negativity bias. Negativity bias depicts our brains operating as Velcro for the negative and Teflon for the positive. Our brains have evolved to be very good at learning from bad experiences, but bad at learning from good experiences. For example, we could have 30 successes in any given day, accomplish all 30 of them, be praised 30 times, but if we had 1 goal we didn't meet or if we received 1 criticism: BOOM!

... we remember that one.

In the "The Self-Acceptance Project," Rick Hanson talks about 4 simple ways to take in the good following the acronym HEAL:

1) Have it - The first step is to have a positive experience in the first place. Either notice when you're experiencing something good instead of ignoring it, or create a positive experience. Marinate these experiences.

2) Enrich It - Stay with the positive experience for 5, 10, 20, 30 seconds in a row. Get those neurons really firing together so they really wire together by helping the experience be as intense as possible and opening to it in your body.

3) Absorb it - Sense that the experience is sinking into you, like water into a sponge or

like a jewel into the treasure chest of your heart.

4) Link it - The 4th step is optional, but powerful. Hold both positive and negative material in awareness at once, but make the positive material more prominent, more in the foreground of awareness, bigger, so that it gradually associates with, soothes, and even eventually replaces the negative material. For example, while feeling cared about by a friend, you could also bring to awareness experiences from childhood in which you felt left out and unwanted.


Life storms will happen. If you can enrich the goodness in your life, these storms have a way of settling. Notice the storm, send yourself compassion and acceptance, get on your own side or be a friend to yourself, and then make a plan are all ways to switch the narrative so we become Velcro for the positive/goodness.

"The person to whom we have the highest moral obligation is the one whom we have the highest influence, and that is our future self. So, if you want to give yourself the gift tomorrow or next year, or perhaps in the next lifetime, treat yourself well" - Rich Hanson.







area around Cattaraugus Creek."

In 1929, Dr. Ralph Waite, a pioneer in the field of dentistry who developed the first oral anesthetic and later perfected Novocain, contributed to the course. Springville's first millionaire, "Dr. Waite gave the club \$1,500 to convert the nine holes to a bent-grass green," said Thomas. "In 1965, the course expanded to 18 holes because it became so popular. It used to take almost an hour to go from Orchard Park to Ellicottville or Springville on Route 391. After Route 219 was built, it turned into just a 20-minute drive, so there was a big boom in business."

Thomas explained that there have been many significant contributions and donations made by Springville locals that have made the course what it is today. "In 1980, George Schichtel donated over 3,000 trees to our golf course. Roger Bugenhagen, our grounds and greens superintendent who was here for 44 years, built eight completely new holes in-house and saved the club millions of dollars." Thomas is looking forward to Bugenhagen's upcoming visit in July, when he will lead a drive-along history of the golf course for members, a centenary event that also includes play of the course's original nine holes.

Since 1990, Thomas has been SCC's golf pro and has seen many changes over the years. "Since I've been here, I helped Roger with the design of six new holes, which was a really incredible experience to be a part of," he said. He's also witnessed surprising changes in club membership, especially in recent years. Thomas explained, "From 2010 to 2019, membership declined at all private clubs, but then Covid hit and you could only play golf! Since 2020, we've probably got 120 new members; it's been a really great thing for our club."

Preserving and remembering the club's history has always been a priority for Thomas, who enjoys sharing the club's artifacts and photographs from the Cascade Park era. "I've always asked people to share with me everything they have about the club," said Thomas, who enjoys the stories, photos, and history of the club's origins. "I love learning about the history of this place, and one of our jobs is to educate our members on the history of the club."


